About our Blue Forest Field trip:

Due to many issues which we all know about, our trip this coming weekend has changed. We will only be going to the Blue Forest on Saturday May 16th.

We will be meeting at the deserted gas station at Fontenelle, WY at 8:30 AM. **Directions:** From Ogden to Fontenelle is about 2.5 hours. Fontenelle is north out of Kemmerer, WY on 189 and a right on 373.

We will of course be digging for petrified wood.

If you have a probe for probing for logs bring it and of course shovel and small pick. I will have a probe that anyone can use.

Be prepared for sun, wind and rain. The current possibility of rain is low but it can rain heavy for 10 minutes and then be sunny. The roads are pretty good but if it rains and you don't have 4 wheel drive you will be there a long time so **no cars please.**

Highly recommend shade items from a trap, umbrella or canopy.

The best time to go to Blue Forest is spring when the soil is soft for digging and probing and that's why we should go this time of year.

Of course as always bring lunch and snacks and lots of water.
