Rock Identification Boxes

The Club will be doing a project together of assembling <u>another</u> "Rock Identification Box" for each family so that they have a "Reference Library" of the rocks we go out rock hounding for on our field trips. <u>This Box will have totally different rocks than the box we assembled last year</u>. Honey Onyx, Bubble Opal, Zebra Rock, Coprolite, Moss Agate, Florescent Rock, Thunder eggs (pieces unless you have tiny one inch size eggs), Red Geodes (one inch size) Black Obsidian.

We would like all of the members to participate in this project. If you don't want a Rock Collection Box you may donate it to the club after you have put it together to give to future new members. Just think how nice that would be for a new person/family!
